The Embassy of the Republic of Cameroon in the Federative Republic of Brazil informs the entire Cameroonian community residing in South America that, in line with the High Vision of modernizing public administration and diplomatic action as initiated by **HIS EXCELLENCY PAUL BIYA, PRESIDENT OF THE REPUBLIC AND HEAD OF CAMEROONIAN DIPLOMACY**, the official launch of second-generation consular services will soon take place.

These services include: the Consular Card, the Ordinary Laissez-passer, and the Mortuary Laissez-passer. They are now fully digitalized and harmonized across the entire diplomatic and consular network.

The Consular Card, a secure identification document for Cameroonians abroad, serves as the main link between nationals and the Embassy. It is essential for accessing several services: renewal or issuance of travel documents, laissez-passer requests, authentication of documents, administrative certificates, etc. It reduces processing times, facilitates procedures, improves communication with the Diplomatic Mission, and allows rapid assistance in case of emergency (accident, loss of documents, arrest, dispute, or serious situation). It is valid for five (05) years.

In accordance with the new digitalized system, applications for second-generation services must be submitted exclusively through the official platform: www.evisacam.cm / www.evisacam.com.

A – The online procedure is as follows:

1. Scan all required documents beforehand.
2. Register on the consular platform.
3. Fill out the form corresponding to the desired service.
4. Upload the necessary documents.
5. Submit the application and proceed with secure online payment.
6. Receive a confirmation email and a tracking number (ID).
7. Download the proof of payment if necessary.
8. Wait for verification and processing by the Mission (3 working days).
9. Provide any additional documents if the application is put on hold.
10. Download the QR Code.
11. Appear in person at the Consulate or Embassy for biometric capture (photo, fingerprints, signature), with original documents in hand.
12. Collect the printed and fully secured document.

NB: An application can only be modified if it has not yet been submitted for processing or if it has been placed on hold for additional information. No refund is possible after submission, except in cases of double payment. Processing time for the ordinary laissez-passer varies depending on the urgency.

B – Required documents for the Consular Card:

- Valid passport (or birth certificate, national ID card, certificate of nationality)
- Permanent or temporary residence permit, or proof of residence in the host country
- Employment certificate or school enrollment certificate
- Marriage certificate, if applicable
- Previous consular card number in case of renewal
- Scans of original documents for the online application, and mandatory presentation of originals during biometric enrollment

C – Issuance fees (stamp duty):

The Cameroonian community in South America falls under the Europe and Americas category: **30,000 FCFA.**

D – Authorized payment methods:

- Mobile Money: **MTN MoMo, Orange Money**
- Prepaid cards: **Visa, MasterCard**

The documents are produced through the following stages: online pre-enrollment, payment, application processing, biometric enrollment at the Diplomatic Mission or Consular Post, then printing and issuance of the final document.

The Embassy therefore invites all Cameroonian nationals in South America to actively engage and make full use of these modern technological tools, designed to strengthen the quality of consular services, ensure data security, and improve assistance to nationals. /-
