



**COMMUNIQUE**

22 JUN 2020

The Embassy of the Republic of Cameroon to the Federative Republic of Brazil informs the public of the resumption of the issuance of entry visas to Cameroon and certain consular documents which were suspended on the 23rd of March 2020 due to the closure of the borders of Cameroon.

As from the 23<sup>rd</sup> of June 2020:

- The presentation of COVID-19 negative test results (obtained within 03 days) from recognized health institutions is now part of the documents required for the solicitation of all entry visas to Cameroon. The Embassy reserves the right to verify the credibility of these tests.
- Visas which were issued at the Embassy but expired during the period in which the borders of Cameroon were closed will be extended for the same period without any additional cost, on the demand of the applicant.
- All application documents for visas and other consular documents must be sent by post office, or through the Embassy's Email address below. This measure, for now, is not relevant to passport applicants, whose physical presence is an imperative condition to obtain the applicant's personal data, which will systemically be done by appointment and with the strict respect of the protection measures put in place by health authorities.
